Roosevelt Elementary Goals

<u>Goal #1: Roosevelt Elementary will strive to have ALL students at proficient or</u> <u>advanced levels in academics.</u>

- A. Continue to offer daily SuccessMaker Math and Reading to all students. Introduce *Study Island* to staff for supplemental intervention use at school and home. Implement *Study Island* school year 2010 2011.
- B. Increase yearly student assessment performance (with a minimum success rate of 85% or higher for Curriculum standards) on the Benchmark Assessments (Limelight) in grades K-6.
- C. 93% of students in grades 3-6 will score the Advanced / Proficient level on the Dakota STEP assessments. Complete STEP data study October 2010 for curriculum progress and modifications. Complete writing / implementing higher level Bloom's thinking skills workshop for staff Grades 3-6.
- D. Roosevelt students in Grade 5 will use the South Dakota 'Write to Learn' program.
- E. Complete TAT interventions for students below grade level in Reading and / or Math.
- F. Complete HOSTS Literacy Support for students in grades 3-6.
- G. Complete Title I Reading interventions for K-2 students and Title I Math interventions for Grades 1-6 students.
- H. Complete the Math CGI Algebra training for staff grades K-6. Continue to use Number Sense CGI training in classrooms. Encourage ALL instructors to team in the classroom with the Title I Math interventionist.
- I. Complete grade level / district training in implementing the Developmental Studies program in grades K-6.

Goal #2: Roosevelt Elementary will provide parents opportunities to actively participate in their child's education.

A. Parent—Teacher Conferences 95-100% of Parents will attend Conferences the 1st and 3rd quarters

B. Fall OPEN HOUSE

95-100% of Parents and students will attend Fall Open House

C. Title I family nights Roosevelt will provide multiple opportunities for families of children receiving Math and Reading Title Services to participate in informational sessions.

D. IEP

Parents will be involved in meetings for students requiring needed supports academically and behaviorally.

- E. PTO Activities Monthly meetings and family nights will be completed at Roosevelt Elementary
- F. Web pages Either grade level or individual instructors will develop and maintain Web pages
- G. Midterm grades summary Completed quarterly for all students in grades 3-6

Goal #3: Roosevelt Elementary will ensure student attendance will meet or exceed the Federal Requirements of No Child Left Behind.

- A. Focus attention and assistance on students and families not meeting attendance requirements. Track and support children / families through the Roosevelt Social Worker.
- B. Provide Quarterly Certificates and End of the Year certificates to students with perfect attendance.

Goal #4: The Roosevelt Elementary students will demonstrate appropriate social behavior skills throughout the school.

- A. The Roosevelt staff will model, pre-teach, teach, and re-teach consistent behavioral expectations with Boys Town Skills.
- B. The Roosevelt staff will continually reward good behavior.
- C. Behavioral Modification Plans and Contracts will be completed with students requiring additional supports.
- D. Social Skills will be highlighted and posted for students to review and model in each classroom. Roosevelt will focus on a 'Top 10' list for students / staff to practice during the 2010-2011 school year.
- E. Roosevelt staff will set, publish, and implement behavioral expectations for students and staff.
